

Law Modifying Articles 3 and 6

of Law 28592, Law that Creates the Integral Reparations Plan - PIR.

Sole Article. Modification of Law 28592, Law Creating the Comprehensive Reparations Plan - PIR Articles 3 and 6(b) of Law 28592, Law Creating the Integral Reparations Plan - PIR, are amended and shall be worded as follows:

"Article 3.- Definition of victim

For the purposes of this Law, victims are considered to be persons or groups of persons who have suffered acts or omissions that violate human rights norms, such as forced disappearance, kidnapping, extrajudicial execution, murder, forced displacement, arbitrary detention, forced recruitment, torture, sexual violence in its various forms or death, as well as the relatives of persons killed or disappeared during the period covered by Article 1 of this Law.

Article 6.- Individual beneficiaries

The following are considered individual beneficiaries:

[...]

b) Direct victims: this includes displaced persons, innocent people who have suffered imprisonment, the tortured, victims of sexual violence in its various forms, and those who have been kidnapped. Also considered direct victims are members of the Armed Forces, the Peruvian National Police and members of the Self-Defence Committees and Civil Authorities who were wounded or injured in actions that violated human rights between May 1980 and November 2000.

Communicate to the President of the Republic for its promulgation.
